- **Keywords:** Three to four (3-4 words)
- Text: Font & size: Times New Roman font, size 11, Single paragraph
- Line Space : Single space
- Word count: 225 words excluding Title, names and keywords

## 1. PowerPoint Presentation Instruction

- Please note that the session room will be equipped with a projector, screen, point device, microphone, and a laptop with Microsoft PowerPoint. We recommend the PPT/PPTX format instead of PPS. ISSED will support only MS PowerPoint. Please ensure that all presentations are in one of these supported formats.
- Please preparing your slides presentation format aspect ratio 16:9; resolution 1920 x 1080).

- If you use a Macintosh Computer (PowerPoint for mac or Keynote presentations) and have transferred your presentation to a Windows format, you must check your presentation to ensure that it is fully compatible with the symposium computers.
- If you plan to use your own computer, please try the connection and make sure it works before your presentation.
- ISSED cannot provide support for embedded videos in your presentation; please test your presentation with the symposium laptop several hours before your presentation to make sure that they are well formatted and connected to the main files.
- Only fonts that are included in the basic installation of MS-Windows will be available (English version of Windows). Use of other fonts not included in Windows can cause wrong layout/style of your presentation.
- There is no size limit for presentations uploaded onsite at the Speaker Centre (it is however recommended that presentations do not exceed 500 MB).
- 2. Presenter will need to prepare USB flash drive and handed to symposium dedicated staffs to copy your ppt/pdf presentation into the laptop in the session room. You can also bring it earlier, during the coffee/lunch breaks of any days before your presentation to make it available in the session room at the time of your presentation.
- 3. Presenter should be in the corresponding session room at least 5 minutes earlier

Internet access will be available to presenters and attendees in all conference areas.
